Diplomacy in Action: Lions Leaders in Washington, D.C,

International diplomacy occurs every day in Washington, D.C. The 68-square mile U.S. capital city is the site of federal offices, foreign embassies and international agencies. Recently, members of the 2004-05 Lions International Board of Directors gathered in here. The directors traveled to Washington, D.C., from 18 countries to participate in the March 30 - April 6, 2005 Board of Directors meeting.

International President Clement F. Kusiak of Maryland, USA, selected the location to provide board members with an opportunity to meet with government officials and organization representatives. The meetings transformed the Lions leaders into Lions diplomats. As such, the directors conveyed the Lions diplomatic message: We Serve. Such as...

Memorandum of Understanding with OAS

Later that evening, President Kusiak signed an historic Memorandum of Understanding with the Inter-American Commission on the Control and Abuse of Drugs (CICAD), a division of the Organization of American States (OAS). The agreement formalized a partnership with LCIF to conduct school-based drug abuse prevention and life skills education programs in OAS member states. The OAS is a pro-democracy intergovernmental organization. Ambassador Luigi R. Einaudi, Acting Secretary General of the OAS, signed the agreement. The formal ceremony occurred in the Washington, D.C. headquarters of OAS. Members of the 2004-05 International Board of Directors witnessed the ceremony. As a result of the agreement, the OAS will match LCIF funds for Lions-Quest programs in the Americas.
