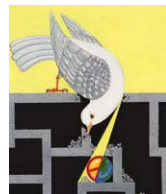

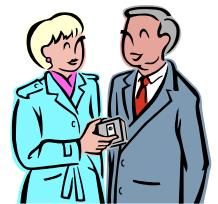
Election Results
